



FEE FOR SERVICES

FEE STRUCTURE

Fees for services provided shall be periodically reviewed by the program administration. Fees shall generally be those established by State and Federal government agencies and programs (such as Medicaid) over which the agency has no control. Typically fees charged to other payers shall be comparable to these governmental compensation rates. Under extenuating circumstances, and by written agreement approved by the agency management, other rates of compensation to the agency for services provided may be negotiated on case-by-case basis. In such situations considerations may include for example the severity of the client's need, the projected duration of such need, the consumer's ability to pay, as well as the agency's financial ability to accept a lower rate of compensation. Consumers will be informed in advance of any fees for which they may be personally responsible. Past due accounts are subject to standard legal collection procedures including the use of outside parties as collection agents.

FEE FOR REPRODUCTION OF RECORDS

There will be a .25-cent fee assessed per page for any client or employee that would like a copy of their record. Clients have the right to view their record through a written request to the agency representative responsible for their care.

FEE FOR DAMAGES

If damages are done to a facility, an employee, another client, or a visitor, the client or employee who caused the damage will owe the cost of repairs to APS. Fees for service cover treatment. They do not cover the cost of damages by the consumer.
