



Covid-19 Visitation Policy

In accordance with the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) May 5th, 2021 guidance, all residents in Alberta Professional Services' homes (licensed and unlicensed) are allowed to have visitors during the Covid-19 pandemic.

Outdoor visitation is preferred, even when the resident and visitor are fully vaccinated.

Responsible indoor visitation, with masks and social distancing, is allowed at any time for vaccinated residents and their vaccinated visitors. All visits should be coordinated with the program director **so there are only two visitors at a time per resident and social distancing can be maintained.** The visitation area should be cleaned with disinfectant after each visit. Non-vaccinated residents and visitors will conduct their visits outdoors.

Visitors that show proof of being fully vaccinated to the program director, can choose to visit indoors, have close contact with the vaccinated resident and may choose not to wear a mask. All other visitors will maintain social distancing and masks.

Visitation at the home will be discontinued if any resident or staff becomes infected with Covid-19.

Residents can choose to visit their families for home visits or vacations. Residents who leave the facility for more than 24hrs AND are not fully vaccinated, will need to quarantine upon their return.

Fully vaccinated residents and staff have the option to choose to if they would like to continue wearing a mask. Non-vaccinated residents and staff will be expected to continue to wear masks.
